Range 5 Baffles



Range 5 is currently being upgraded with 3 extra Baffles.

A small group of dedicated volunteers are working hard to achieve this.

Members will soon be able to participate in the VAPA 'Service' Match.

There are Club Pistols available to shoot this match, with the Club ammunition.

The Service Pistol event for 9mm and .38/.357 pistols consists of 90 shots fired

at distances varying from 50 to 7 yards with the pistol holstered at the commencement of each series or can be shot without a holster from a 45 degree start position.

Shooters wanting to use a holster must hold a current PA Holster Accreditation. PA Service Pistol targets are used for this event and set in a bank of four targets per shooter
